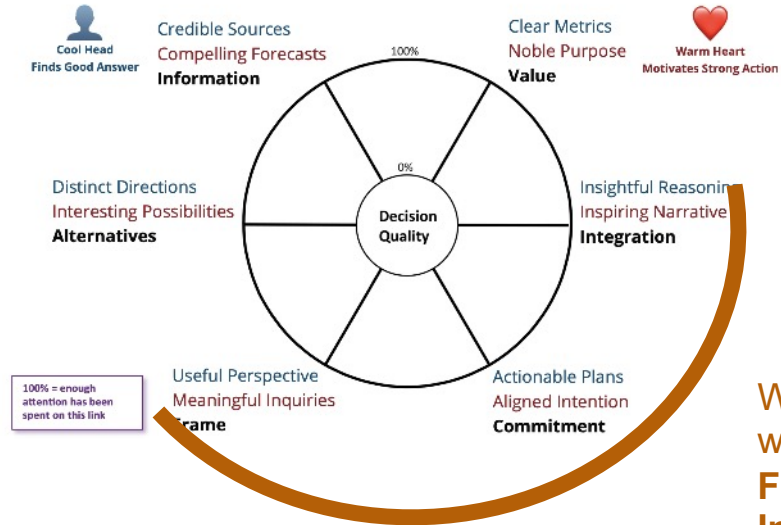


Commitment

Actional Plans = concrete executable steps and milestones that coordinate the implementation.

Aligned Intention = powerful people want the new direction and will take corrective action when things go awry.

The “connection” of the decision



We've been discussing how a decision connects to the real world:

Frame = Context and reason we are deciding this

Integration = How the basis comes to a conclusion and bridged into the future

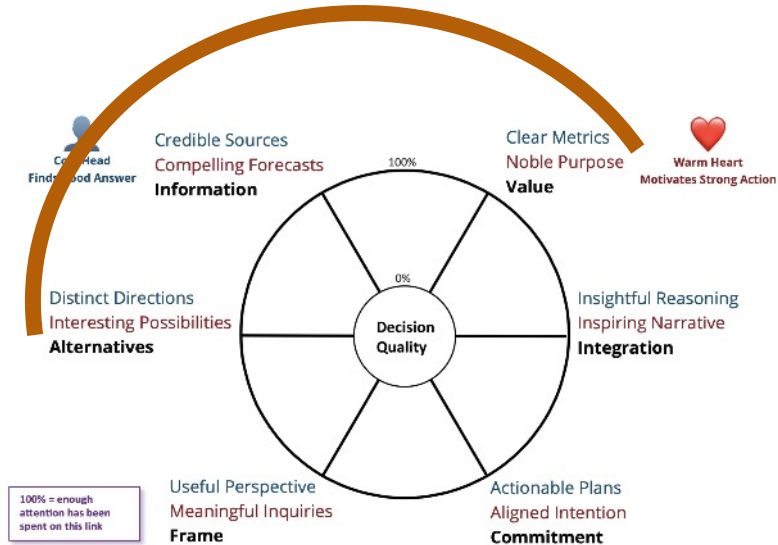
Commitment = The reality of making things happen



The “basis” of the decision

Alternatives, Information and Values are collectively the “**basis**” of the decision, what might be contained in a briefing package for example.

Approaches to engineering decision quality

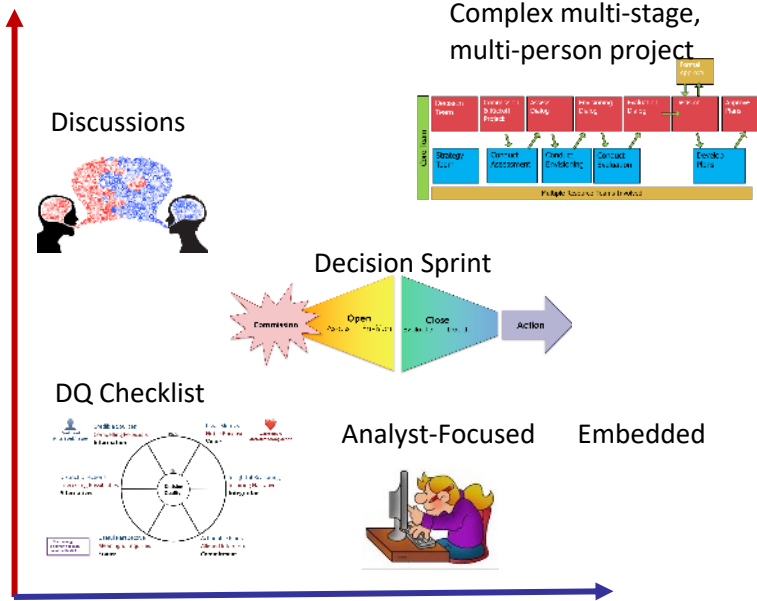
- Use Decision Quality as a check list to quickly get to “good enough”.
- Decision sprint: take a pause to get to a think things through, e.g. run a workshop
- Conduct a significant decision project, e.g. corporate strategy or college selection
- Embed into a work process so decision quality created along the way, e.g. stage-gate process



The greater the decision complexity, the greater attention to the decision process

Heart complexity:

- Difficulty for people to make & accept decisions
- Lots of change / new future
- Organizational complications



Head complexity:

- Difficulty of finding a solution that is in our best interest
- Uncertainty, Volatility, Ambiguity
- Scope / difficulty of conducting an analysis
- Creativity required

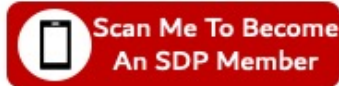
